Issues found & Recommendations

Issue	Area	Fix	Priority
Empty link present in menu	Menu	Remove empty link from menu	Medium
Menu aria labels are not descriptive for the link that is currently selected	Menu (Desktop)	Aria Labels are set to "Subject Link" for all links, meaning a screen reader cannot read them. Either remove the aria label or update it.	High
Footer headings are H3's but do not have a natural flow from H1, H2, H3.	Footer	Update footer code to show menu headings without the use of Heading tags.	Low
OneTrust cookie icon showing as button with no accessible name	Site Wide	Add aria-label to cookie button to give it a readable name May not be possible due to loading onetrust in via javascript.	Low
Twitter image pixels are flagged as missing alt text, meaning they are potentially read as images by screen readers	Site Wide	Add Aria Hidden labels to twitter image tags so screen readers do not treat them as actual images.	Low
Vacancy filter has redundant alt tag on close icon	Apprenticeships	Remove alt tag from the close icon as it is the same as the text next to it, meaning a screen reader reads the text twice.	Medium



Slick slider has aria-hidden values that are focusable but out of viewport	Apprenticeships (but also an issue on every slick slider e.g. Art & Design page, Digital Tech page)	Hide aria-hidden true elements within the slider. This will require some testing and transitions to achieve a fade in effect and avoid harsh slide entrances.	Medium
Accordion does not have the correct role=tab setup	Subject (Art & Design, but also visible on other pages e.g. subject summary, term dates)	Add the additional aria-role's required to correctly implement an accessible tablist.	Medium
Page has a large whitespace where an image should be placed.	Subject - Art & Design	Remove image tag when not in use, or fix image and add alt tag.	Medium
Images flagged as having redundant alt text	Homepage Our Campuses	The text for this images alt text exists immediately after the image, meaning screen readers read it twice. Either update the alt text on the image to be more descriptive of the image, or remove the alt text to avoid it reading twice.	Medium
Broken link on page relating to the "Are you still unsure?" section	Subjects	Remove section or update it with a link and image	Medium
Application form consent tick boxes are hidden from screen readers, making it impossible to submit a form.	Application Form	Update the tick boxes to make them available to screen readers	High
